

MEMORANDUM
OF COOPERATION BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE AND PUBLIC
SECURITY OF THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL AND THE
MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION IN THE
AREA OF ROAD SAFETY

The Ministry of Justice and Public Security of the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Ministry of the Interior of the Russian Federation, hereinafter called Parties,

ATTRIBUTING great importance to the development of international cooperation in the area of road safety;

TAKING into account the fact that traffic accidents are one of the major causes of mortality;

CONSIDERING the resolutions' and instruments' provisions of international law on road safety adopted in accordance with the United Nations regulation;

GIVEN that the Parties hosted the First and Second UN High Level Conferences on Road Safety; and

ACTING within their competence and in accordance with the domestic laws and international commitments of their respective countries;

come to a mutual understanding of the following:

1. The Parties are willing to exchange experiences, information and content on the following subjects:

I. inspection of observance of legal rules and regulations in the area of road safety;

II. traffic regulation;

III. participation in activities of protection and preservation of public order and safety;

IV. search and identification of hijacked and stolen automotive vehicles;

V. notification of administrative violations in the area of road safety;

VI. application of emergency measures to rescue people at traffic accident sites;

VII. indicators registration of road safety conditions;

VIII. study of traffic conditions, application of measures to improve the organization of vehicle and pedestrian traffic;

IX. vehicle chase;

X. preparation of proposals to increase road safety;

XI. identification and elimination of causes and conditions that contribute to the occurrence of traffic accidents, violation of traffic rules and other unlawful acts that threaten road safety.

2. The Parties shall ensure the completeness and authenticity of the information provided.

3. Under this Memorandum, the Parties will not exchange information, access to which is limited in accordance with the legislation of the States of the Parties or international treaties to which the States of the Parties are members.

4. The Parties are prepared to support each other in staff training and expert training and to undertake, by mutual agreement, internships, conferences, scientific seminars, workshops and consultations under this Memorandum.

5. The Parties may, within their respective competencies and in accordance with their respective domestic laws and international treaties, make contacts on other aspects of road safety not specified in this Memorandum.

6. For the purpose of direct contacts under this Memorandum, the Parties hereby designate:

(a) by the Brazilian Party: the Federal Highway Police Department of the Ministry of Justice and Public Security of the Federative Republic of Brazil;

(b) by the Russian Party: the General Coordination of Traffic Safety of the Ministry of the Interior of the Russian Federation.

7. Each Party shall bear its own costs incurred in carrying out this Memorandum.


8. Cooperation activities between the Parties under this Memorandum will be conducted in Portuguese and Russian.

9. This Memorandum shall remain in effect from the date of its signature until its termination, which shall occur after six (6) months from the day following receipt by either Party of a written notification from the other Party of its intention to denounce it.

10. This Memorandum is not an international agreement and does not establish rights and obligations under international law.


